Product characteristics:

Nopal are shoots or tender stalks 10 to 15 cm long, fleshy, green and flattened, which are eaten as a vegetable.

Description:

Intense green color. The nopal make up the plant group with the most soecies and wider distribution of cacti. They are characterized by their flat stems or paddle-shaped stalks, covered with small clusters of stiff hairs called glochids and usually spines too.

Appearance: Oval shaped vegetable.

Shelf life: 10-15 days.

Storage condition: 4-6 °C / 39-42 °F
